Casting Our Care On The Lord - Philippians 4:6-7 Rev. Dr. Ernest Brodie Jr.

Philippians 4:6-7: "Be careful for nothing; but in **everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God**. And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus." Prayer is often the answer to anxiety for the believer. This is a prayer of trust, not of doubt, accusation, or blame. Believers can cast all their care upon the Lord at any time (1 Peter 5:7)

1. **God promises to support us in His wisdom** (James 1:5). Apart from God's wisdom, we are easily swayed. We must continually call upon God for wisdom, strength, and direction.
2. **God promises that no trial will be too difficult to handle with His help** (1 Corinthians 10:13). While we may think that we cannot handle another thing, God can. There is nothing he will not carry us through. There is nothing He cannot handle. Our duty is to turn the matters troubling us over to Him.
3. **God promises that all which takes place will ultimately be used for good** (Romans 8:28). There are times when we do not understand what the Lord is doing; however, He will always accomplish good in the long run as we submit to His will in our life.
4. **God keeps His promises** (2 Corinthians 1:20). There are many promises in the Bible which apply to believers and that bring great comfort. He promises to never leave us nor forsake us (Hebrews 13:5). He promises to walk with us through the valley of the shadow of death (Psalm 23:4). He promises His strength to us (Isaiah 40:29).
5. **God knows that suffering leads to a believer's perfection, establishment, and strengthening** (1 Peter 5:10). Peter writes about spiritual growth. The process of growth for a believer does not take place without difficulties. There are growing pains at times. God often removes the dross or that which is unprofitable to Him from our life through the difficulties we face.
6. **God exhibits divine power in the time of need.** 1 Peter 1:3-5 shows that believers are kept by the power of God. God possesses the power to keep us since He is worthy of all glory, honor, and power (Revelation 4:11).
7. **God promises to relieve our suffering.** 2 Corinthians 4:17: "For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, worketh for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory."

We can turn to the Lord at any time in prayer. We can turn to Him with a heavy heart and with thanksgiving knowing that He is God. He will hear our requests, and He holds the power to make a difference. As a result, we can experience peace even in the midst of fiery trials, because we know Him.
