What Will You Do With Jesus?

John 12:12-19 portrays the triumphal entry of Jesus into Jerusalem to celebrate the Passover. The people were joyfully shouting, "Hosanna: Blessed is the King of Israel that cometh in the name of the Lord." We celebrate this event on Palm Sunday. Who was this Jesus?

Jesus had a miraculous birth. The angel came to Mary: "Thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name Jesus. He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: and the Lord God shall give unto him the throne of his father David: And he shall reign over the house of Jacob for ever; and of his kingdom there shall be no end. The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God." (Luke 1:31-33, 35)

Jesus had a miraculous ministry. He made a lame man walk (John 5:5-9), He healed a man who had been born blind (John 9:1-7), He raised Lazarus from the dead (John 11:38-44), He stilled the wind and the waves (Matthew 8:23-27), and He fed over 5,000 people (Matthew 14:15-21). There are many more examples of Jesus' miraculous ministry throughout the Gospels. The biggest miracle of all is Christ dying on the cross for our sin. 2 Corinthians 5:21: "For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him."

Jesus conquered death. 1 Corinthians 15:3-8: "For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures; And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures." There are many eyewitness accounts to the resurrection of Jesus.

What did people believe about Jesus?

In Matthew 16:18, Peter answered Jesus: "Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God." We see what Peter believed in 1 Peter 1:3-5.

In John 18:35-38, Pilate questioned Jesus: "What hast thou done?" (verse 35), "Art thou a king then?" (verse 37), and "What is truth?" (verse 38). Pilate found no fault in Jesus and wanted to release Him, but he eventually ended up turning Him over to be crucified.

After severely persecuting the church, Paul was dramatically converted to Christ (Acts 9). From that point on, he diligently preached the Gospel and recognized that man's only hope is in Christ. Romans 10:9: "That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved."

On Palm Sunday, Jesus put before the people the opportunity to accept or reject Him. It is not enough to intellectually know facts about Jesus. What do you believe, and what will you do with Jesus?
