Things That Defile - Matthew 15:1-20 Rev. Dr. Ernest Brodie Jr.

In Matthew 15:1-2, the scribes and Pharisees asked Jesus why His disciples transgressed the traditional ceremony of washing their hands before eating. They were looking for a way to accuse Him and the disciples of doing something wrong. This tradition became more important than the Word of God.

- Obedience is always more important than the traditions of men (verses 3-9). Jesus challenged the scribes and Pharisees, "Why do ye also transgress the commandment of God by your tradition?" Traditions of men can get in the way of following the Word of God. Unless a man's heart is right with God, his worship is unacceptable.
- Obedience is more important than what we eat (verses 10-11). "Not that which goeth into the mouth defileth a man; but that which cometh out of the mouth, this defileth a man" (verse 11). It is not what you eat that makes you unholy but what is in your heart. God wants our obedience.
- Obedience to the Word of God is more holy than following the crowd (verses 12-14). Be careful who you follow. They may lead you away from God.
- Obedience to the Word of God is the only way to deal with issues of the heart (verses 17-20). Again, it is not what we eat that makes us unholy, but what comes from our hearts. Jeremiah 17:9: "The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked: who can know it?"

The Lord knows our hearts. May we learn to measure them by His Word and not by the traditions of men. Our only hope is in Jesus Christ. May He bless our daily walk in a way that gives Him all the glory and honor.
