## Memorial Day - Deuteronomy 6 Rev. Dr. Ernest Brodie Jr.

We call those who sacrifice for the sake of others, heroes. Memorial Day was originally called Decoration Day in honor of those who fought and died in the Civil War. It became a federal holiday in 1971. The sacrifices of other generations are also remembered: The War of 1812, World War I, World War II, The Vietnam War, The Korean War, The First and Second Gulf Wars involving Iraq and Afghanistan. These sacrifices are important, because few would be willing to sacrifice all for the sake of others. Noble deeds are costly.

In the Old Testament, God stresses the importance of keeping His commands and rehearsing truth with the next generation. Deuteronomy 6 is an example of this. Deuteronomy repeats the commands of the Lord for the generation which grew up in the wilderness. Moses reminds the people to **mark** the events, **remember** the power of the Lord, and **recount** the stories to their children and grandchildren. In doing this, God would bless them. The fear (deep reverence) of God was essential in honoring and obeying Him (verse 2). God promised to bless those who revered Him (verses 2b-3). Love for the Lord would keep the people obeying Him (verse 5-6) and speaking of Him (verses 7-9).

### Creating Memorials:

- **Mark** - Take note of special events in your own life as well as in history.
- **Remember** - On special days, take the time to think about the events, places, people related to those events.
- **Recount** - Tell the next generation about others who have gone on before. Rehearse biblical accounts and make application.

Perhaps the greatest danger to obedience to God is prosperity, success, and ease. It is often during times of ease we forget the trials of the past. We forget what it was to be lost and bound by sin. We lose sight of the times others sacrificed so that we might hear the gospel message. Most of all, we forget what Christ did for us on the cross as we become too busy living life. It is interesting to note that life can get in the way of eternal life.
