False Prophets - Matthew 7:15-20 **Rev. Dr. Ernest Brodie Jr.**

The Danger of False Prophets (Matthew 7:15a).

Jesus warned, "Beware of false prophets." False prophets declare false messages or lies that may sound good, but they do not speak the truth. God's people are not to hearken or follow them, but "walk after the Lord your God, and fear him, and keep his commandments, and obey his voice, and ye shall serve him, and cleave unto him" (Deuteronomy 13:4).

The Deceitful Nature of False Prophets (Matthew 7:15b)

False prophets "come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly are ravening wolves." They are smooth talkers claiming to speak for God, but instead are seeking personal gain and popularity.

The Identification of False Prophets (Matthew 7:16-20)

"Ye shall know them by their fruits" (verse 16). What they are and what they believe will be revealed through careful observation. The importance of knowing doctrine helps believers to identify false prophets by what they say and what they don't say.

The Future Punishment of False Prophets (Matthew 7:19-23)

Jesus said, "Every tree that bringeth not forth good fruit is hewn down and cast into the fire" (verse 19). False prophets will spend eternity in the lake of fire. They may deceive many on earth, but they will not deceive Jesus Christ.

People will go to hell for rejecting Jesus Christ. John 3:18: "He that believeth on Him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God." Are you trying to look like a Christian? Are you following a false teacher and neglecting the Word of God? We must determine to know what God's Word says, so that we will not be seduced by false prophets.
