### **Why Is Jesus Christ Worthy of Our Worship? - Matthew 9:18-26** **Rev. Dr. Ernest Brodie Jr.**

Why is Jesus Christ worthy of our worship? Matthew addresses this in Matthew 9:18-26 by showing Jesus' power over disease and death. He is worthy of our worship because He is accessible, touchable, and powerful.

#### **1. Jesus is accessible** (Matthew 9:18)

Many of the Scribes and Pharisees failed to recognize Jesus as their promised Messiah and had sought to trip Him up (Matthew 9:10-13). Can you imagine their reaction when they saw a ruler, Jairus, approaching Jesus? Jairus was one of the highest religious leaders in the synagogue at Capernaum. Jesus receives anyone who comes to Him.

Jairus is a father, who loves his daughter, and she has died. He believed that Jesus could help. Deep needs and tragedy bring people to Jesus. Jairus bowed and worshiped Jesus. He knew his daughter was dead, but he asked if Jesus would come and lay His hands on her, so that she might live. Faith in Jesus alone is true for our salvation also.

#### **2. Jesus is touchable** (Matthew 9:19-22)

Jesus was on His way to Jairus' house, and we learn of a woman coming to Him. She was pressed within the crowd. She believed she would be made whole, if she touched the hem of Jesus' garment. This woman's disease classified her as being untouchable and unclean. Her hope was in Jesus, and she reached out to touch Him. Her faith in Jesus not only brought her physical healing but salvation from sin.

#### **3. Jesus is powerful** (Matthew 9:23-26)

When Jesus arrived at Jairus' house, there was great chaos among the crowd gathered. They were wailing and mourning. They laughed scornfully at Jesus when He said the maid was not dead but was sleeping. Jesus silenced the crowd when He took the maid's hand and she arose! Jesus is the resurrection and the life (John 11:25).

Jesus worthy of our worship. He worthy of our service and sacrifice. There is no one else that is like our blessed Savior.
