**With respect, honor, and gratitude  
for all veterans on Veterans Day**

**Veterans Day** is observed annually on November 11. Major hostilities of World War I ended at the eleventh hour of the eleventh day in the eleventh month in 1918 when the Armistice with Germany went into effect. One year later, on what became known as Armistice Day, Americans came together to remember and honor the sacrifices of the men and women who served during the war. Congress declared Armistice Day a national holiday in 1938. In 1954, Congress changed the name of the holiday to Veterans Day to include veterans of all United States wars. On Veterans Day, we want to express our deep appreciation to all who have served or are currently serving in the armed forces.

The official, national Veterans Day ceremony is held each year on November 11 at Arlington National Cemetery. The ceremony commences precisely at 11:00 a.m. with a wreath laying at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. A color guard representing all branches of the military executes "Present Arms" at the tomb, a presidential wreath is placed on the graves, and a bugler plays "Taps." The ceremony is intended to honor and thank all United States military veterans
