Christmas Gifts for Pastor Ernie - Our church leadership encourages you to consider a financial Christmas gift for Pastor Ernie in appreciation of his ministry to you and your family this year. There are two ways to do this. They have different tax implications.

1. You may make a donation by check or cash directly to the Pastor, and the church is not involved. The donor does not have anonymity which is sometimes of interest. The donor gets no tax deduction, and the gift is tax-free to Pastor.
2. You may make a donation by cash or a check made out to the church with a notation on the check or envelope that it is for a Christmas gift for the Pastor. The donor gets anonymity and a tax deduction. The Pastor will receive the gift. The amount will be included on his W-2 form at the end of the year, and he must pay federal and state taxes on it.

Today, December 25 is the last day we can receive such gifts and arrange for payment to Pastor this year.
