Mother's Day - Devout Women of Faith **Rev. Dr. Ernest Brodie Jr.**

There are many devout woman of faith in the Bible and in church history. Judaism and Christianity elevate and encourage godly women by giving them a voice and protection and providing a platform for ministry. What is a godly woman?

1. **A godly woman is one who knows the Lord.** Knowing God is more than knowing about God. Knowing God is about having a daily walk with Him, knowing what He expects, understanding what He delights in, and experiencing His faithfulness. This is far more than factual information. It is an experiential knowledge (Psalm 37:1-5).
2. **A godly woman is one who is passionate about the Lord.** Passion relates to commitment. (Psalm 42:1, Romans 12:1-2)
3. **A godly woman is dedicated to God.** To be dedicated to someone is to hold the chief interests, desires, and needs of that person as important. To be dedicated to God means that He is central in our thoughts and actions. (Colossians 3:1-4)
4. **A godly woman is continually growing and learning.** A godly woman loves to learn and grow. In Proverbs 31, there are a number of verses which describe the characteristics of a godly woman.

We should be thankful for godly women.

1. Take time to thank a godly woman who sacrificed on your behalf.
2. Thank the Lord for bringing this godly woman into your life.
3. Emulate the good characteristics of this godly woman and be that example to someone else.
