Marks of a Spiritual Man **Rev. Dr. Ernest Brodie Jr.**

It is God's desire that every man be truly a man of God and a spiritual leader. True spirituality originates from God. We must look to God to learn what a spiritual man is like.

1. Spiritual men have the right priorities.

Spiritual men keep God's commandments (Deuteronomy 4:2). They obey God's Word and live for Him. They keep their eyes on Him and are not drawn away by sin. Spiritual men put God first.

2. Spiritual men have a right attitude.

- Meekness - Not weakness but power under control (Galatians 6:1-6).
- Faith - (Hebrews 11:6).
- Humility - Unselfish yielding to the needs of others. (Philippians 2:5)
- Thanksgiving - An attitude of gratitude (1 Thessalonians 5:18). God has done so much for us, and we should be grateful.

3. Spiritual men have right relationships.

God should be first, then family, and then friends. (Deuteronomy 4:29, 39). Be sure the characteristics of the friends you choose are honesty, respectful, godly, patient, and kind.

4. Spiritual men have the right loves. Deuteronomy 6:1-9

This relates to a man's passions. The correct order is God first, then family. Be passionate about God and do things His way, and He will guide you and your family.

5. Spiritual men have the right communication.

Spiritual men do not argue for the sake of an argument and do not stir up strife (Ephesians 4:29). Men should not be gruff, tough, and hard in their communication.

6. Spiritual men have the Word of God in their hearts. (Psalm 119:11, Hebrews 4:12)

Spiritual men, who desire to be leaders, need to be students of God's Word, but having a knowledge of God's Word does not necessarily mean you are spiritual. Being spiritual means you portray the character of Christ in your actions.
