Marks of a Hero - Hebrews 11 **Rev. Dr. Ernest Brodie Jr.**

Memorial Day is a time for us to remember those who sacrificed their lives for our country and the freedom we have. We all know someone who gave their life for our country, and we consider them heroes. What is a hero? In Hebrews 11, we see the "heroes of the faith" taking God at His word, following and trusting Him, living their lives faithfully for Him, and doing what is right. What are the marks of a hero?

1. A hero knows his duty and does it. (Proverbs 10:28)
2. A hero acts with purpose. He continues his duties with integrity, even if it costs him his job.
3. A hero willingly sacrifices for the sake of others.
4. A hero considers the eternal.

True heroes of the faith:

- Abel did not go to God on his own terms, but he came God's way with the approved blood sacrifice. Cain (and the world) rejected it. (Hebrews 11:4)
- For years, Enoch faithfully followed God whether he was mocked or not. (Hebrews 11:5)
- Noah faithfully followed God's Word. (Hebrews 11:6)
- Abraham left willingly and followed God. (Hebrews 11:7-10)
- Moses forsook the riches of Egypt to follow God. (Hebrews 11:23-30)
- Joshua and Caleb believed that God could give them the land.
- David stood fast showing faith instead of fear.
- Daniel purposed in his heart to follow God.
- Peter and John continued to share the gospel even though they might receive a beating.
- Paul faithfully proclaimed the truth.

Jesus is the greatest hero of all. God incarnate! He came to die on the cross for our sins, was buried, and rose again on the third day for our justification (1 Corinthians 15:3-4). He is the only Savior for mankind (John 14:6, Acts 4:12). He came and gave His life that we might have eternal life (Acts 2:21, Romans 10:9, Romans 10:13). Do you want purpose in life? Determine to take God at His word, follow and trust Him, and live your life faithfully for Him. Be one of the heroes of the faith!
