Why Should I Live for Christ Today?

1. Duty demands it. Our responsibility as believers demands we live for Christ, no matter how we feel.
 - As soldiers of the cross - 2 Timothy 2:3-4.
 - As servants of the King - Ephesians 6:5-8 encourages us to be consistently faithful in our service for Christ. We are to be faithful with enthusiasm, even when it is not easy or whether we feel like it or not.
 - As stewards of truth - 1 Peter 3:15 reminds us that we are accountable to God.
2. Joy requires it.
 - Nothing else brings joy like living for Jesus - 1 Thessalonians 3:1-13 is the testimony of Timothy. It was a comfort to Paul to hear of those who had suffered much and were still following the Lord.
 - Knowing our purpose brings joy - Philippians 4:5-10.
 - Making a difference as a believer brings joy - Philippians 2:16. May we purpose to make a difference in the lives of others.
3. Love encourages it.
 - Constrained because of Christ's love for us - 2 Corinthians 5:14-15.
 - Compelled by His death for us - 2 Corinthians 5:21.
 - Captivated by the love of Christ through our trials - 2 Corinthians 12:7-10 tells of Paul's thorn in the flesh given to him as a messenger of Satan. He prayed three times to be relieved of it, but God chose to show Paul that His "grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness" (verse 9). Sometimes we have to live with the problems of life, that we may learn to glorify God.

Have you put your faith and trust in Jesus' death, burial, and resurrection for your justification? Make sure you genuinely know Christ as your Savior. 2 Corinthians 13:5 exhorts us to: "Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith." Are you prepared for Christ's return?
