Real Change - Ephesians 4:17-23

According to Ephesians 4:17-23, God tells us exactly what He wants us to remove from our lives in order to bring Him honor and glory. God commands us in verse 17: "Walk not as other Gentiles walk." We are to stop living like the ungodly. In Ephesians 4:17-19, there are eight things that show how the ungodly act.

1. "In the vanity of their mind" (verse 17). The ungodly are vain. They live for temporal things while ignoring the eternal.
2. "Having their understanding darkened" (verse 18a). The ungodly are in the dark when it comes to spiritual things. They do not think about God or care about His Word (Romans 1:21-22).
3. "Being alienated from the life of God" (verse 18b). The ungodly are alone, in spite of their popularity or their many friends. When it comes to critical issues of life or death, they are separated from God.
4. "Through the ignorance that is in them" (verse 18c). The ungodly are ignorant. God warns us not to be ignorant (Romans 1:13, 1 Corinthians 10:1, 1 Corinthians 12:1, 1 Thessalonians 4:13, 2 Peter 3:5, 8). Willful ignorance of the truth is sinful and foolish.
5. "Because of the blindness of their heart" (verse 18d). The ungodly are blind to the things of God. They are in total darkness and without the light of God's Word.
6. "Who being past feeling" (verse 19a). The ungodly have no conscience and are callous and hardhearted.
7. "Have given themselves over unto lasciviousness" (verse 19c). The ungodly have given themselves over to sin. They are engrossed and encompassed in sin (2 Timothy 3:1-9).
8. "To work all uncleanness with greediness" (verse 19c). The ungodly are eager to sin. They cannot wait to sin (Romans 1:32).

Ephesians 4:20-23: "But ye have not so learned Christ; If so be that ye have heard him, and have been taught by him, as the truth is in Jesus: That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts; And be renewed in the spirit of your mind."
